I advise you from the papers in the Revolutionary
War pension claim, R.4846, it appears that Valentine Hefner or Heffner was born in 1758, in Germany, and came to
America when he was an infant.

He alleged that while residing near Chambersburg, Pranklin County, Pennsylvania, he enlisted and served as a private with the Pennsylvania Troops as follows:

From the lat of June, 1777, six months in Captain
Daniel Glappeaddle's Company in Colonel Johnson's Regiment and was in a skirmish on Ridge Road near Germantown;
from September, 1778, three months in Captain Heiser's
Company in Colonel Johnson's Regiment! in the summer of
1779, one month in Captain Gadwallader's Company, in Colonel Allison's Regiment.

He applied for pension August 14, 1837, at which time he was living in Walker Township, Huntingdon County,
