

we were compelled to retreat - which being done in great confusion, part of us lost ourselves, and thus defendant was out ten days, and the first place he came to was Wheeling Fort - he remained here about ten days recruiting himself - when he returned home to Washington County - defendant was out on this tour two months and three weeks. His officers to this tour were Captain John Reador 1st Lieutenant and John McDonell. William Crawford was Colonel. David Williamson was Lieutenant Colonel. Daniel Right was Major.

Answer I was born in Baltimore County State of Maryland in the year 1768.

Interrogatory 2^d Have you any record of your age, and if so where is it?

Answer No - I never had. I derive the information of my age from my mother, who is long deceased.

Interrogatory 3^d Where were you living when called into service? Where have you lived since the Revolutionary war? and where do you now live?

Answer I was living in Washington County Pennsylvania when called into service, and lived there two years after I returned. I then came to Shetley's valley, in Jefferson County, Pennsylvania, in the year 1794. In the year 1795 removed from thence to Stone Valley, in Birney township, Huntingdon county, Pennsylvania, where I now reside, and have ever since resided.
